The **Edmonton Chinese Bilingual Education Association (ECBEA)** and the **Chinese Graduates Association of Alberta (CGAA)** are seeking volunteers to help out at the **Chinese Pavilion** during the 34th Annual **Edmonton Heritage Festival 2009**. Come out for a day of fun and sun, meet people from all over the globe, and best of all, come celebrate Chinese culture, tradition, and food!

Who can help?

Anyone can! *No experience is needed*, and on-site training will be provided to all. This is an excellent opportunity for students to earn volunteer credit. (Age 14 and over preferable, under age 14 requires parent/guardian supervision).

When will volunteers be needed?

At least one or more shifts from Wednesday July 29th to Monday, August 3rd, 2009

During the festival:

- Saturday, August 1st: A) 10 AM – 5 PM, B) 2 PM – 9 PM – 70 shifts
- Sunday, August 2nd: C) 9 AM – 4 PM, D) 2 PM – 9 PM – 70 shifts
- Monday, August 3rd: E) 9 AM – 4 PM, F) 2 PM – 9 PM – 70 shifts

Sunday and Monday evening shifts are most needed!

What will volunteers be doing?

Volunteers can help fill the following positions:

- Demonstrate and sell Chinese arts/crafts
- Serve food and/or drinks to festival visitors
- Food/drink preparation/transportation

We hope to see you out there!

- Entertain visitor with fortune telling game
- write Chinese calligraphy
- Run the sound system for stage performers, MC-ing
- Help out with miscellaneous tasks around the site
- Site set-up/take-down(July 29-August 3, 7pm-11pm)
- Transport volunteers/equipment to the festival site(Age 25+ with valid Alberta driver's licence)
- Teach visitors to speak some Chinese, any dialect
- Perform your talent at the Chinese Pavilion Stage e.g. singing, dancing, drumming, playing musical instruments etc.
- Demonstrate various Chinese artistic cultural skill e.g. painting, drawing, crafts, dough arts, playing Chinese yo yo, etc.
- Play a demonstration sport/act on stage e.g. acrobats, martial arts, clowning, etc. --- **Performers are welcome!**

Are there perks for the volunteers?

- Chance to win one of 11 \$250-400 Heritage Festival Scholarship by draw(minimum 10 volunteer hours) To be announced by Heritage Festival (EHFA), **Post-secondary students only**
- Chance to win one of 10 \$100 Chinese Pavilion Scholarship by draw(minimum 10 volunteer hours) **(5) for Post-secondary students and (5) for grade 6-12 students**
- Lunch included at the Chinese Pavilion
- Pick up and return into the park at a designated location(ASSIST Community Service Center)
- Great learning experience and have fun at the same time
